MB1/O Mountbatten Papers: Miscellaneous papers

MB1/O contains miscellaneous papers that were extracted from their original files during the 1970s. A small number of whole files were also taken from MB1/L and relocated in MB1/O. The files are arranged either by subject or correspondent. The majority of the material dates from after Lord Mountbatten's retirement in 1965.
